

## LEBANON CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE MINUTES

November 4, 2019 – 7:00 p.m.

### ORDINANCE

1. The committee suggested that the city moves forward on the ordinance concerning retail sales of cannabis
2. The committee recommended that the section 2-29 of our ordinances be amended to reflect a change of 4 member to 5 members.
3. The committee recommended to submit for approval the Food Truck Ordinance
4. The Planning & Zoning recommended discussion of the scope and responsibilities of the Lebanon Planning & Zoning Commission for updating to the Ordinances and the approval of City Council.

### PUBLIC PROPERTY

1. The committee has recommended NO PARKING signs for the ambulance area and with a suggestion that maybe it be stripped in front of door.
2. Discuss possible sidewalk repairs in worst areas.
3. Mr Witte asked for relevant images, photos, logos, and colors for new Municode website.

### STREETS/ALLEY

1. Committee will continue researching the repair processes and monies to complete the restoration of the brick street.

### OLD BUSINESS

1. Information gathered by Chairman Witty informs the committee that there are no “grants” for the two or three sirens needed by the City. The cost of new sirens is upwards of \$50,000.00 apiece. The county (ESDA) recommends CODE RED warning system is a good system to encourage all citizens to enroll.
