Dear Mayor Abner:

The State of Illinois, acting by and through its Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the City of Lebanon, in order to facilitate the free flow of traffic and to increase the safety to the motoring public, is desirous of improving FAP Route 314 (IL Route 4), from approximately 20 feet south of the CSX Railroad crossing in the City of Lebanon northerly to approximately 104 feet north of Blue Spruce Lane in Madison County, by removing a portion of the existing pavement surface utilizing the milling method and resurfacing with $\frac{3}{4}$ inches of Leveling Binder (Machine Method), N70 with $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches Hot-Mix Asphalt Surface Course, Mixture "D", N70, constructing an Aggregate Wedge Shoulder, Type B and Concrete Gutter, Type B along either side of IL Route 4 where applicable; removing and replacing Steel Plate Beam Guardrail, Type A along either side of said route; removing and replacing Raised Reflective Pavement Markers and replacing Thermoplastic Pavement Marking throughout the project and by performing all other work necessary to complete this improvement in accordance with the approved plans and specifications, to be known as Section (110, 111)RS-4.

The anticipated letting date for this project (Contract No. 76E29) is April 29, 2011.

This letter is to advise you that the State will make the surveys, prepare plans and specifications, receive bids and award the contract, furnish engineering inspection during construction, and cause the improvement to be built in accordance with the plans, specifications and contract, and pay all costs thereof.

The estimated construction cost of the improvement is \$2,300,000.

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Upon completion of the improvement and so long as IL Route 4 is used as a State Highway, the State shall continue to maintain or cause to be maintained those portions of IL Route 4 now maintained by the State.

Upon completion of the improvement, the City of Lebanon shall continue to maintain or cause to be maintained any portions of IL Route 4 within the City limits now maintained by the City.

Please be advised that this project does not affect or modify the terms of any Agreements or Letters of Understanding between the State and the City of Lebanon concerning IL Route 4. All such existing Agreements and Letters of Understanding shall remain in full force and effect.

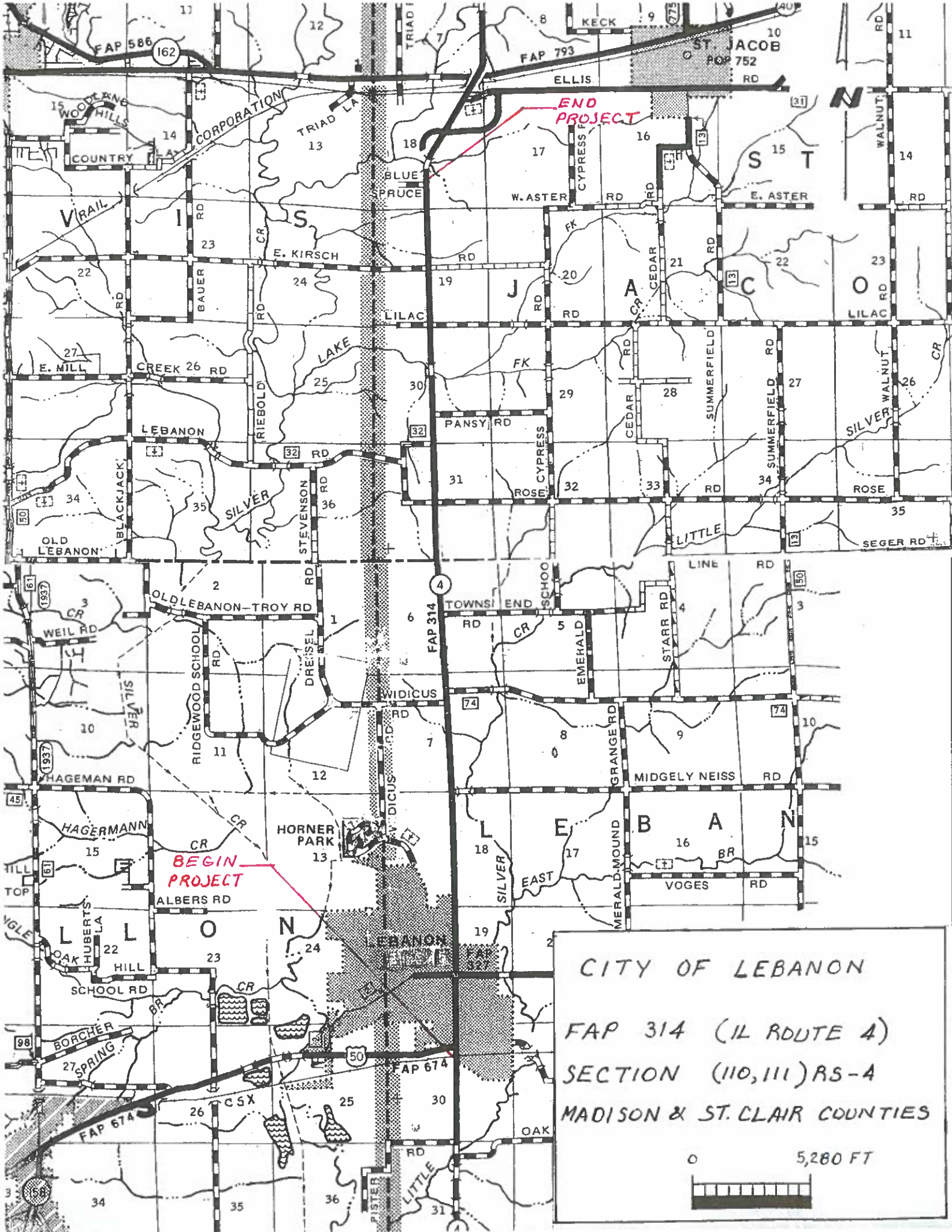
